



Philly Summer Showcase
Queen of the Crease Competition

20 goalies will compete in a shoot-out competition in front of the Showcase before the All-Star announcements.

There will be 3 Rounds:

Round 1: Round of 20

Round 2: Round of 8

Round 3: Championship (final 2)

Round 1 (of 20 goalies)

1. There will be 5 goalies, two shooters, and a scorer at each of the 4 cages. Goalies will be assigned to a cage.
2. Round 1: At all 4 cages, each goalie will take turns getting 6 consecutive shots (2 high, 2 low, 2 middle) from two alternating stationary shooters (2 from each of the 3 designated shooting zones). The 2 goalies with the highest # of saves are the winners of Round 1.
 - a. If there is a tie of any kind, (three, four or five way tie), each remaining goalie will face a single-elimination round from the same stationary shooter. (all shots from each round must be similar placement)

Round 2 (of 8 goalies)

1. The two Round 1 winners of each cage will report to Cages 1 &2 for Round 2.
 - a. Cage 1 and 2 winners will meet at cage 1 for Round 2
 - b. Cage 3 and 4 winners will meet at cage 2 for Round 2
2. During Round 2, there will be 4 goalies at two cages who will face 6 consecutive shots from 2 alternating shooters who shoot on the run. (2 high, 2 low, 2 middle)
 - a. If there is a tie of any kind, (three, four or five way tie), each remaining goalie will face a single-elimination round from the same shooter on the run. (all shots from each round must be similar placement)
3. The top goalie at each cage advances to the Championship

Round 3: Championship (of 2 goalies)

1. The two Round 2 winners of each cage will report to Cage 1 for the Championship Round.
2. During the Championship, there will be 2 goalies at Cage 1 who will face 10 consecutive shots from 2 alternating shooters who shoot from stationary shooting zones. (These shots can be placed anywhere)
 - a. If there is a tie, goalies will face a single-elimination round from the same shooter on the run. (all shots from each round must be similar placement)
3. The top goalie is the most saves is the Queen of the Crease!

Other Notes:

1. If it would count as a goal in a game, it counts as a goal (balls that bounce backwards into the goal after a save is not considered a save)
2. Shots taken outside the shooting zones will not be counted.
3. Hitting the pipe is considered a save.
4. Goalies cannot distract others when it is their turn
5. Goalies who are not shooting should stand in a safe area away from the cage.
6. Goalies must be properly equipped as per USL guidelines
